Lintel & 2 doorposts struck with blood (Ex. 12:7)	Lambs roasted in fire and eaten w/unleavened bread and bitter herbs (Ex. 12:8-11) The LORD (YHWH) passes through the land and passes over the houses with blood on the doorposts and directs the destroyer to slay the firstborn of man and beast in Egypt at midnight (Ex. 12:12-13; 23-29)	Pharoah and all Egyptians rose in night and there was a great cry in Egypt for all households had at least one dead. Pharoah called for Moses and Aaron by night and told them to go and serve the LORD (Ex. 12:30-32)	The Israelites left with boldness in the sight of all the Egyptians because the Egyptians were burying all their firstborn (Num. 33:3-4) The Egyptians feared so they urged the Israelites to leave in haste. As they left, they asked the Egyptians for silver, gold, and clothing - plundering them (Ex. 12:33-36) Israelites must stay in houses until morning (Ex. 12:22) About 600,000 adult Israelites, plus children, plus a great multitude, plus livestock were traveling from their homes to the Egyptian border (Ex. 12:37-38) It would take all day for upwards of 1 million people to travel on foot and assemble at the Egyptian border	14th day of 1st month (Passover)	15th day of 1st month (1st Day of Unleavened Bread)
				It was on the Feast of Unleavened Bread that God brought Israel out of Egypt (Ex. 12:17) The LORD brought the Israelites out of Egypt <u>by night</u> (Deut. 16:1) It was a <i>night</i> of solemn observance for bringing the Israelites out of Egypt (Ex. 12:42) The fifteenth day of the first month is the Feast of Unleavened Bread (Lev. 23:6)
